The award is not available for personal purchase. The recipient is awarded a certificate and pin. The recipient's name shall be posted at the Lion Max Simms Memorial Camp.

The Judge Brian Stevenson Fellowship is not available for personal purchase, and can only be obtained by a club, district, multiple district or a person who wishes to honour a deserving individual.

Judge Brian Stevenson has requested that the fee of \$500.00 CAD be used to build an endowment fund for Lions Foundation of Canada with the interest annually supporting the Dog Guide programs. The recipient will receive a Judge Brian Stevenson medallion, lapel pin and signed certificate.

How do clubs apply for a Harry A. Newman Diabetes Award?

1. An award is issued for a contribution of \$800.00 donated to the Canadian Diabetes Association designated for the Harry A. Newman Diabetes Award.
2. The total cost of the award must be contributed to the Canadian Diabetes Association in one lump sum.
3. You may give any number of awards in any given year to any designated person(s) or Clubs.
4. All proceeds will be used for diabetes research in Canada.
5. Awards will be processed upon receipt of the \$800.00 contribution.

LIFE MEMBERSHIP

Any member of a club who has maintained Active membership as a Lion for twenty (20) or more years;

Or any member of a club who has maintained such Active membership for fifteen (15) or more years and is at least seventy (70) years of age;

Or any member of a club who is critically ill and has rendered outstanding service to his/her club, his/her community, or this Association;

may be granted Life Membership in the local club upon (1) Recommendation of his/her club, (2) Payment to the Association of US\$650.00, or its equivalent in the respective national currency, by his/her club in lieu of all future dues to the Association.

A life member must continue to pay club and district dues as applicable.
